Bradley Manning, a 24-year-old Army intelligence analyst, faces life in prison for allegedly sharing the “Collateral Murder” video of a US helicopter attack that killed 11 civilians and wounded two children in Baghdad, Iraq with the WikiLeaks website.

*Bradley Manning Support Network* campaign organizer **Jeff Paterson** will be visiting Bellingham to provide a multi-media presentation including:

- An overview of US v. Bradley Manning
- His report from the Fort Meade courtroom where Bradley had his first court hearing after 18 months of pre-trial confinement, while hundreds of supporters marched on base December 16-22.
- Updates on the international grassroots campaign.

In August 1990, Corporal Jeff Paterson became the first of many US military personnel to refuse to fight in Iraq. Today, Jeff is the project director of *Courage to Resist*, an Oakland based organization dedicated to supporting GI war resisters and conscientious objectors, and helps lead the campaign in support of Army PFC Bradley Manning.
